Position Description:

We anticipate this course being taught on-campus using a face-to-face modality.

About the Course:

This course focuses on the entirety of the employee training process, including topics and issues related to training needs analysis, program design and implementation, and the evaluation of training effectiveness. Theoretical advancements, empirical research findings, and practical applications of psychological concepts related to employee training and development are covered.

Minimum Qualifications:

Master's degree in a relevant field is required.

Preferred Qualifications:

PhD in psychology and previous teaching at college level are preferred.
