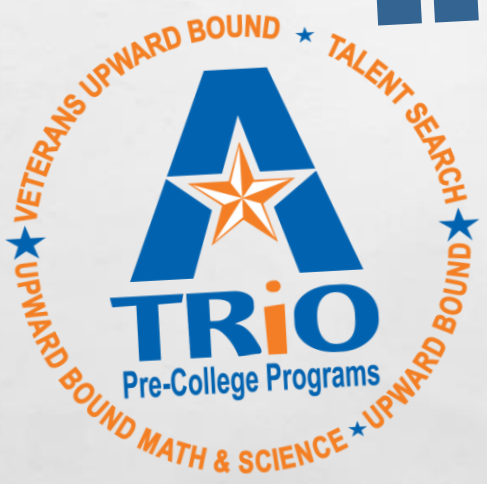

BAKE FOR GOOD

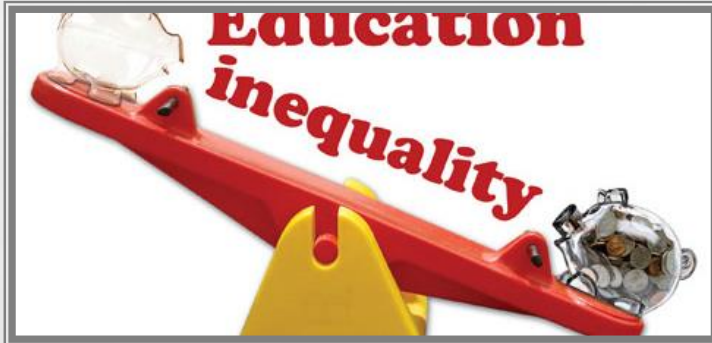
